## PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE

It's been an honor serving as president of the Valley Elementary Educational Foundation. It's been an amazing year! To recap, we raised \$37,000 at the inaugural Fall Gala and Auction event, we purchased nearly 700 new books for the library and we have dispersed nearly \$4,250 in mini grants to help pay for books, supplies, programs and field trips.

Perhaps most exciting was this year's 4th Annual Cinco de Mayo Trail Run. We registered 993 runners, about three times the number that participated last year. We were supported by more than 100 volunteers. We invited the foundations from seven other schools, as well as Chelsea's Light Foundation, to participate in a program that brought in 392 participants. We partnered with 66 sponsors — up from 20 the year before. We had 20 exhibitors, up from 12 the year before. And we grossed approximately \$48,000, compared to last year's gross earnings of \$22,000.

This kind of event doesn't just happen. It takes hundreds of people working over the course of many months. Thank you to the following groups: the Foundation board, especially event chair Megan Schirmacher; the planning committee; the sponsorship team, the students, teachers, administrators and parents who supported and participated in the event; the volunteers; and, of course, the partners, sponsors and benefactors who contributed financially to make the event such a success.

I'm the last remaining founding member of the Foundation. As I complete my tenure on the board, I admit that it's exciting to end with a record-breaking year. I challenge you to keep up the momentum as we plan our next big event, the Fall Gala and Auction, scheduled for October 16. I have no doubt that the coming year holds even more promise!

money raised to good use in the 2010-11 school year by purchasing the first phase of a Web-based curriculum called CompassLearning for every classroom at every grade level.

## MENSAJE DEL PRESIDENTE

Es un honor servir como presidente de la Fundación. Ha sido un año fantástico, hemos logrado recaudar la suma de \$37,000 en la inauguración de Gala de Otoño y en la venta silenciosa de remate, hemos comprado casi 700 libros nuevos para nuestra biblioteca y disponemos cerca de \$ 4,250 en pequeñas donaciones para ayudar a pagar por libros, útiles y programas por paseos.

Quizá lo más estimulante fue este año la 4ta Carrera del 5 de Mayo. Se registraron 993 personas para correr, tres veces más el número de los que participaron el último año.

Tuvimos la ayuda de más de 100 voluntarios. Invitamos de las fundaciones de otras 7 escuelas, como también a la Fundación de Chelsea's Light, para participar y trajeron 392 participantes. Nos unimos con 66 personas que nos apadrinaron — 20 el año anterior — tuvimos 20 exhibidores — 12 el año anterior. El gross recaudado fue aproximado de \$48,000 comparado con el año último de \$22,000.

Esta clase de evento no sucede simplemente. Es el resultado del trabajo de más de 100 personas durante muchos meses.
